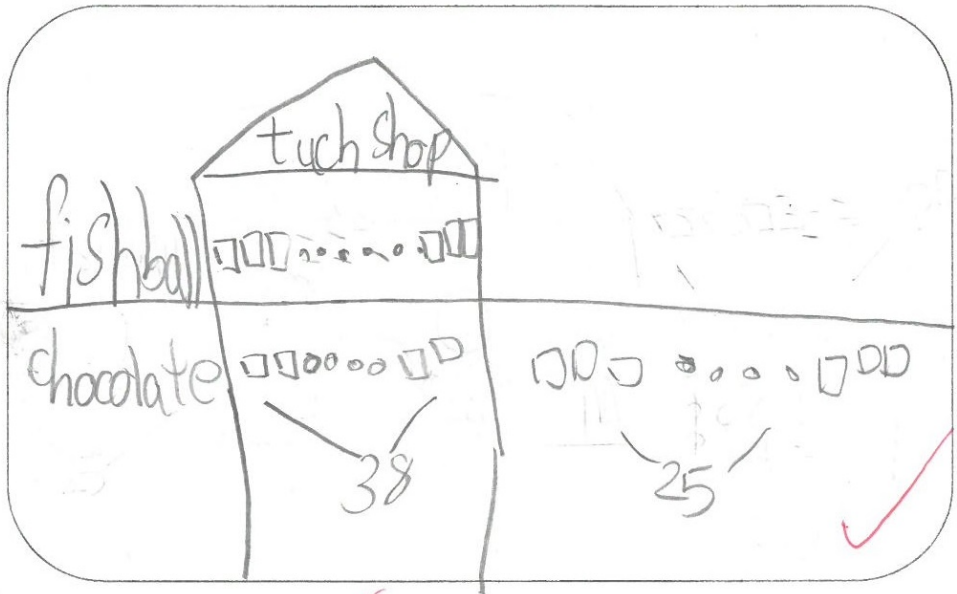

$$= 63$$

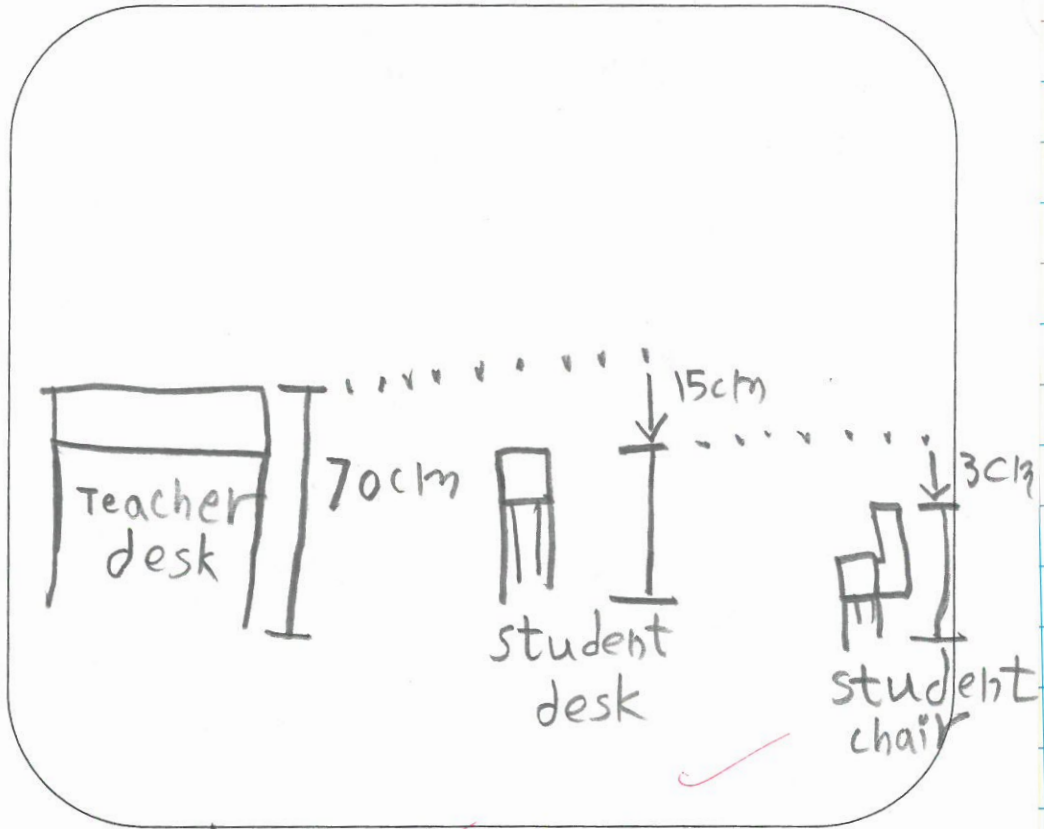
There are 63 chocolates

In the classroom, the teacher desk is 70 cm tall. The student desk is 15 cm shorter than the teacher desk. The student desk is 3 cm taller than the student chair. What is the height of the student chair?



$$\begin{array}{r} 70 - 15 - 3 \\ \hline = 52 \end{array}$$

The height of the student chair
is 52 cm.
